1474 persons in four detention camps

One-thousand fourhundred and seventyfour (1474) persons are held in custody at the detention camps of Boossa, Pelawatte, Weerawila and Kalutara, upto:10 January '93, the statistics of the Legal Aid Centre of Bar Association disclose.

These detention camps are supervised by the Commissioner of Prisons. 640 persons are detained at Boossa, 290 at

Pelawatte, 61 at Weerawila and 483 at Kalutara, upto 11-1-93.

Meanwhile, another 1141 inmates are undergoing rehabilitation at the six rehabilitation camps, at Bandarawela, Anuradhapura, Puttalam, Ratmalana, Piliyandala and Pallekelle, according to statistics.

The welfare of the detainees and the persons undergoing rehabilitation is looked into by the Human Rights Task Force.
