

President's killing: 5 taken in for questioning

Five Tamil youths, who were suspected associates of Kulaweerasinghe Krishna Kumar, the alleged assassin of the late president, have been taken into custody by the

C.D.B. probing the assassination of president Ranasinghe Premadasa.

These suspects, the police believe were closely moving with the suicide bomber when he was living at Keselwatta.

Police are questioning the suspects, to ascertain, whether they were at the Armour Street junction, at the time of the bomb explosion.

In the meantime, Police believe that the photographs showing the main

suspect Krishna Kumar with some security personnel was an attempt to mislead the police, in their investigations.

Meanwhile the C.D.B. has detained three Tamil youths for further interrogation.
