(VIII) International Movement against all Forms of Discrimination.

The Report stated that there were over a dozen NGOs including the above involved in that abortive exercise. It is, therefore, pertinent to find out from the President and the Government whether action is being taken at the highest level to investi- gate into this treacherous act and drive away bag and baggage all such NGOs found involved, out of the shores of Sri Lanka never to set foot again.
