Escapee Tamil militant nabbed at B'desh border

A suspected Tamil militant was arrested by Indian security forces while he was trying to cross to Bangladesh through the Kalamati border, reports from New Delhi said.

LTTE chief, Prabhakaran, was one of the 43 who had escaped from Vellore Jail in Tamil Nadurecently, police said. He was sent to police remand after being produced in courts.

The militant who introduced himself as a close associate of
