

Prabhakaran will trick Chandrika, too

Ja-Ela: Before long Prabhakaran would trick his sister, Chandrika, in the way he had tricked J. R. Jayewardene and Premadasa and Rajiv Gandhi.

So said Anura Bandaranaike at a presidential election meeting held at Ja-Ela.

He said that even the fourth strongest army in the world, the Indian Army, could not conquer this LTTE.

Gandhi who had tried to solve that problem was killed and even President Premadasa who truly tried to solve that problem was killed.

Now 32 items had been released to the North and the LTTE had

responded by killing 33 naval officers and had sunk two ships.

But when one of their party members was accused of being involved in a case of murder and was in hiding, instead of skinning him, he was appointed a deputy minister.
