

## Canadian relief for North-East

The Canadian Relief Organisation for Peace in Sri Lanka (CROPSL) has informed the Jaffna Government Agent K. Manikavasagar that arrangements are being made to send relief and aid services

to Tamils in the North-East.

Secretary of CROPSL, Chris Sandrasagara in his letter to Mr. Manikavasagar states that the Canadian government is giving his organisation all possible assistance and co-operation to

make the project a success.

The letter states "We are making arrangements now to send the following items of aid to the Northern Province as soon as possible:

- (a) drugs for distribution to the hospitals in the North
- (b) food-such as wheat flour, sugar concentrate, etc.
- (c) clothing and nutrients including canned food, baby food, etc. for undernourished children.
- (d) Wheel chairs, crutches, hearing aids for disabled persons
- (e) hospital equipment such as X-ray plants, operating theatre apparatus, medium size generators and tents (for the use of refugees)
- (f) financial assistance for extremely destitute people
